Black Light Mural "Trails" Coming to Downtown



In conjunction with the Halloween Lantern Parade on October 28th, Historic Downtown Kendallville is also planning to install several **Blacklight Murals** throughout the downtown area as a fun and unique "scavenger hunt" type of experience for the community. As many as five or six murals will be installed within the next week, with plans for more in the future.

These small-scale murals are being created by local artist Chris Lesley, and the first set will have a Halloween theme. Blacklight murals can only be seen with a blacklight flashlight -- and cannot be seen with the naked eye. Historic Downtown Kendallville will have flashlights available on the night of the lantern parade.


