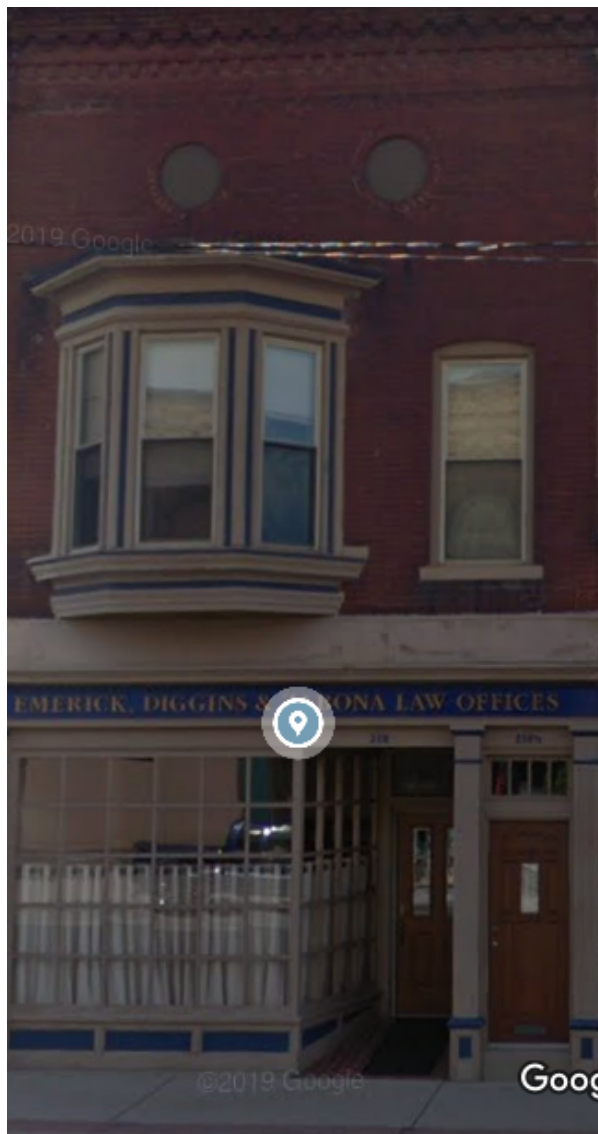

This survey is intended for small business owners. It includes up to 21 questions and will likely take about 10 minutes to complete. No individual responses will be published or shared in any personally identifiable way.

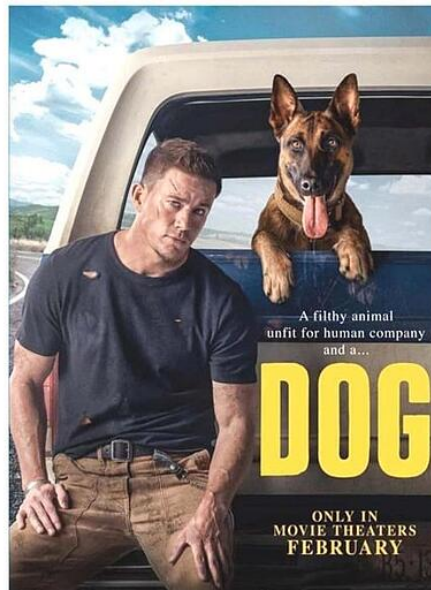

The Four Point Approach to Main Street

Economic Vitality: Rooted in the commitment to making the most of a community's unique sense of place and existing historic assets; harnessing local economic opportunity; and creating a supportive business environment for small business owners and entrepreneurs.

Design: Supports a community's transformation by enhancing the physical elements of downtown while capitalizing on the unique assets that set the commercial district apart.

Promotion: Positioning the downtown district as the center of the community and the hub of economic activity, while creating a positive image that showcases a community's unique characteristics.

Organization: Ensuring that all organizational resources (partners, funding, volunteers, etc.) are mobilized to effectively implement the Community Transformative Strategies.
