Art on Main 2025

Raised Planter Beds and Dog Houses Will Soon be on Display!

The artwork for this year's **Art on Main Project** has started to roll in and will soon be on display in and around Historic Downtown Kendallville.

This year, the project includes 8 raised planter beds, along with 4 fun dog houses, all expertly designed by local artists from around the community.

We've provided a few photos below of some of the amazing pieces that have already been dropped off, so you get an idea of what to expect. Our goal is to have all artwork out on the sidewalks before Memorial Day.

Each piece will include the name of the artist, the name of the piece and/or a description of what inspired their design, as well as a QR code that will allow patrons to bid on their favorite, so that they can purchase and take it home with them at the end of the summer.

MapMe Tool Will Soon Be Available


Dynamic Mapping Tool will Create Custom Maps, Drive Visitors, Provide Data

Several organizations across Noble County have partnered to purchase a dynamic mapping platform called **MapMe**, which will allow us to create maps of various community assets, including (but not limited to) shopping maps. scavenger hunts, walking tours, specific site, camping and trail maps, and much more.

A sample (DRAFT) map of downtown Kendallville can be seen below. While this map is still a "work in progress", we welcome and encourage feedback from users to make sure we are providing the best and most accurate information possible.

RainWorks Project

We're on a mission to plant "hidden" RainWorks murals across our community -- and you can help!

But first . . . what is a RainWorks mural? It's a sidewalk mural that shows up whenever it rains. Take a minute to watch the video below to learn more and see

how it works.

How can you get involved? We are looking for sponsors/donors to help cover the cost of purchasing large stencils for the project. These can be artistic or can be words of encouragement and hope (we're open to your suggestions, as long as they are family friendly!).

If you are interested, please let us know. Your support will help us purchase the large stencils needed to make a visual impact; and will also allow us to make a smaller stencil of your logo to go along with one of the RainWorks murals.

The estimated cost of one RainWorks mural (approximately 2 ft x 3 ft) plus a stencil logo is \$50-75 total, and the murals are expected to last for about 4-6 months -- so they will be visible throughout the summer and fall every time it rains.
