



Kendallville's Newest Mural Comes to Life!

It would be hard to miss the mural that was recently installed at the corner of Main and William Streets (on the side of the Atz Law building).

This beautiful mural was made possible through a generous grant from the Indiana Destination Development Corporation (IDDC) as part of their "IN Indiana" tourism campaign. State officials want this new tourism campaign to be a "really big megaphone" that helps people promote the Hoosier State. According to Elaine Bedel from the IDDC, "Life Is Better IN Indiana' speaks to our quality of life and place -- and the Hoosier pride we all have," Bedel said.

The mural spells out KENDALLVILLE, with each letter filled in with a significant scene or backdrop from Kendallville, such as the Apple Festival, Atz Ice Cream, and Bixler Lake Park. The mural also includes a map of Indiana, highlighting the major thoroughfares that connect visitors to our great city. The mural was designed and painted by local artist Chris Lesley and is meant to serve as a backdrop for photos and "Instagram moments."

Currently Seeking Vendors

The Vintage Market is returning to downtown Kendallville this fall during Apple Festival weekend, and we'd like to personally invite you to participate in 2022!

This year, we will be holding the event on **both** Saturday and Sunday (October 1 & 2) from 9:00am until 4:00pm.

Vendor fees cover participation over both days, regardless of whether you elect to stay for both days of the event or not. For those who stay for both days, the Kendallville Police Department has agreed to patrol the area overnight to prevent theft and eliminate the need for tear down on Saturday night.

Vendors who only want to participate on Saturday should let event organizers know in advance, so that your booth is appropriately placed for easy tear-down.

Booth fees are as follows:

\$75 per 12'x12' space for Food & Craft vendors.

\$25 per 12'x12' space for any not-for-profit organization vendors


