Congratulations to **Madison Tremaine**, our 2025 Christmas in July winner. Madison won \$500 in Chamber Checks, just for shopping local during our summer promotion!

Here are a few other cool outcomes from the contest:

- Shoppers information provided included individuals with area codes representing 16 different states around the country, including California, Alaska, and New York
- The contest generated \$13,780.02 in spending/receipts at locally owned small businesses around Kendallville
- There were 173 total participants, representing over 500 entries in the contest
- The average amount spent per participant was \$79.65

This immersive experience offers direct access to industry experts, targeted educational resources, one-on-one mentorship, and a powerful network of fellow entrepreneurs. Join a community of driven entrepreneurs and get the tools you need to start or transform your business!

This program will dive into the most critical elements of business management to provide participants with the tools needed to tackle your big goals.

As an added bonus, participants will have the opportunity to compete in a pitch-style competition for a chance to win a variety of awards to help spur business growth and development. Launching your new business just got way easier!

What's included in the BELT Program?

- A 10-week business accelerator cohort where you will receive hands-on training from field experts on every aspect of launching your small business
- Access to FREE one-on-one mentoring/coaching opportunities with a professional in the area where you need it most
- Ongoing wrap-around support from the NEI Small Business Development Center (SBDC) and the NEI Innovation Center (NIIC)

Once completed, participants will have the opportunity to compete in an interview/pitch competition for a chance to receive one or more resources to launch/grow your business:

- A graduated lease on a storefront property in the 4-county region to launch their business
 - Rent will start at \$240/month and increase incrementally over the course of one year, freeing up capital for other business priorities
- A low-interest loan of up to \$2,500 to launch their new venture & leverage additional funding (3 available)
- 1-year Chamber membership in the county of choice in the 4-county region (4 available)
- 1-year DABA membership for one DeKalb County participant (1 available)
- QuickBooks training from Mannia & Company (4 available)
- Free to all: headshot session at pitch party, capital access map, personal journal & pen for note taking

- Personal studio space at a coworking/incubator space (based on current availability):
 - 231 Main Co-working (Kendallville) 5 available
 - Co-work Steuben (Angola) –10 available
 - DeKalb Co-working (Auburn) 5 available
 - Registration fee reimbursement (\$125)
 2 available
- 6-month membership at the CLC Cookery (shared kitchen space)
 - Includes 20 hours/mo. access to equipment, storage, freezer/fridge, personal locker, water use, cleaning supplies & high-speed Wi-Fi
- Free marketing start-up bundle (custom logo, business card and brochure design, social media set up) (4 available)
- Other awards currently being pursued include: free assistance with first year tax filing, free legal consultation, etc.


